Resolution 2025 - 001

Recommendation of the Town of Chilton Plan Commission to adopt the *Calumet County 2045 Comprehensive Plan*

WHEREAS, § 66.1001(4) Wis. Stats., establishes the authority for a county, city, village, or town to adopt a comprehensive plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chilton has engaged in a comprehensive planning process under §66.1001, Wis. Stats., to update its comprehensive plan originally adopted in 2012; and

WHEREAS, Calumet County and the partnering municipalities of the City of Brillion, the Villages of Hilbert and Potter, and the Towns of Brillion, Brothertown, Charlestown, Chilton, New Holstein, Rantoul, and Woodville, undertook a multiyear process of incorporating and updating existing plans to draft one cohesive comprehensive plan that focused on the next 20-year timeframe, containing all elements specified in §66.1001(2), Wis. Stats.; and

WHEREAS, the comprehensive planning process included public participation procedures that met the requirements of § 66.1001(4)(a), Wis. Stats., ensuring that residents and stakeholders were provided meaningful opportunities to participate; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Chilton has actively participated in the comprehensive planning process through public meetings, working group sessions, and content review, in coordination with the participating municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has reviewed the draft *Calumet County 2045 Comprehensive Plan* and finds that it will serve as a guide for future development, preservation, and investment decisions consistent with the community's vision; and

WHEREAS, the final version of the *Calumet County 2045 Comprehensive Plan* can be found on the County's website at: https://calumetcounty.org/183/Comprehensive-Planning

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Plan Commission of the Town of Chilton recommends adoption of the *Calumet County 2045 Comprehensive Plan* to the Town Board, pursuant to §66.1001(4)(b), Wis. Stats.
